2025-2026 Terms of Agreement - Please Read Carefully

- **Payments 5 days past due for any reason will result in a discontinuation of service WITHOUT NOTICE. To reinstate service overdue payment must be made in full as well as a 2% Late Fee**
- **30 days written notice is required for cancellation of service for any reason.** Payment will be required for the cancelled month if the required notice is not provided.
- **Payment is still due even if your child/children does not use the bus service due to illness (related or unrelated to Covid-19), personal vacations, school holidays or closures, professional activity day, poor weather or for any other reasons not listed above.**
- Notification is required by text or email **before 7:00am** if busing is not required that day. Also, parents must please contact us if your child misses the bus in the morning and **still requires** afternoon busing, if your child leaves school early or stays late for any reason, if you are picking up your child from school or if your child will be on vacation.
- Sometimes drivers require days off, and a spare driver is provided to cover the run. Please note, it is not the responsibility of the office to let the parents know.
- **Children must adhere to the Rules of the Bus. These rules will be strictly enforced.**
- **T.G.T. Inc. has a five (5) minute wait time at the school from the bell. Please talk to your child & teacher about getting to the bus promptly. If the bus is missed, parents must pick up the child.**
- In case of poor weather conditions or if **area school buses are cancelled, T.G.T. Inc. will be cancelled.** Please view our Facebook or WhatsApp Parent Portal Group or contact the office at **905-490-0402 (by phone or text)** for any changes or cancellations. **This is your responsibility as T.G.T. Inc. does not call each family.**
- T.G.T. Inc. reserves the right to cancel or discontinue service for any reason if service can no longer be made available, and if applicable, a refund may or may not be provided.
- **We reserve the right to cancel or suspend service without notice for any reason including but not limited to, defacing and destruction of property, for mischievous or disruptive conduct, bullying/fighting/assault on the driver or other riders and/or if service can no longer be accommodated.**

RULES of the T.G.T Inc. School-Bus

Nothing is more important to T.G.T Inc. than the safety of your child while in our care. We are always continuing to strive to create a safe and enjoyable ride for all the children, as well as our drivers. As a result, we have come up with some rules on the bus that if followed, allow the children to have the best bus experience they can:

- Children must always remain in their assigned seat. At no point during the ride is the child permitted to leave the seat unless instructed by the driver and done at a safe and proper time.
- **No Cell Phones or Game Electronics are allowed to be used on the bus.** This includes I-pods, I-pads or anything related with or without headphones. Any electronics caught being used will be taken and kept with the driver for the duration of the bus ride and returned to the child at their disembarking location. This is for the safety of your child's property as well as the safety of the other children around who may be viewing the device.
- No large objects to be allowed on the bus. This includes large school projects, snow sleds, skateboards, etc. If your child needs something for school, it will be your responsibility to get it to and from your child's location. The driver has the right to refuse any item they deem too large or unsafe. Any questions contact the office before sending it with your child.
- **No bullying on the bus. Physical or verbal bullying of other students/drivers will not be tolerated on the bus. T.G.T. Inc. has a HANDS-OFF policy on the bus, so any touching of another child/driver will not be permitted. No verbal bullying, no teasing, name calling, or hurtful words/phrases are to be used on the bus. Bus suspensions will be enforced if necessary.**
- Children are to use indoor voices on the bus. Screaming or inappropriate loud noises will not be tolerated.
- Masks are to be worn when necessary. No spitting on or at anyone/thing, throwing "spitballs" or any saliva exchanging.
- No throwing of objects on the bus or out the windows. This includes hats, mittens, scarf's, backpacks, toys, or any other loose objects that may be on/with a child.
- There will be a **5-minute** wait time at the school from the bell. If your child has not reached the bus at that time and is left behind, it will be your responsibility to get them from the school. Please talk to your child and teacher about getting to the bus promptly.
- **No open Food or Drink of any kind is permitted to be consumed on the bus at any time.**
- 1st warning will be a phone call to parents, 2nd warning will be a 3 to 5-day suspension (depending on the incident) and 3rd warning will result in cancellation of service without a refund.

Drivers need to be focused on their #1 task, which is driving and when the driver encounters fewer distractions, the safer the ride will be for your children. It is important that you review these rules with your child and ensure they understand that failure to comply with these rules will result potential removal from service.
